that on the 9th Aug. 1731 John Wilson of H County
& Province Inn keeper personally appeared before us
the Subscribers two of the Justitices of the said Proprietary
Justices of the Peace for the County and to keep a signed
and Acknowledged to owe unto to the said Right Hon. the Lord Proprietarie
the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling money of his Goods and Chattels Lands
and Tenements to be made & levied conditionally if a certain Joan Anderson
his Servant doth not personally appear before the Justitices of the Peace at
Chester Town in said Kent County the third Tuesday in June next to answer
unto such Musters & Misdemeanors as shall be then & there objected against
her on his Lordships behalf particularly on Sustencion of feloniously taking
Lands goods of William Sidmarsh & Lydia Bruton and shall in the mean
time be of the good Behavior and not depart the Court without licence
then this Recognizance to be void otherwise to remain in full force

said County on the third Tuesday in June bearing the fifteenth day of said Month
Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and thirty one came the
