 wards to wit the day & year last mentioned came against the said Lord by  
 Tomb Francis the Clerk of Judgments of this Court and Joan Anderson in her  
 proper person and the Jurors of that Jury being Impanelled and called —  
 likewise came to wit Robert Dunn George Griffith Philip Davis John  
 Williams John Hunt Thomas Maffey William Smith Chris<sup>m</sup>. Bolman Jun<sup>r</sup>.  
 Tooby John Browning Luk<sup>m</sup> Madelon and Jacob Perkins who being duly  
 called in and Sworn to say the truth the promises upon their Oath do  
 say Joan Anderson <sup>is guilty</sup> of the Felony aforesaid as the Murder indicted and by Robert  
 Dunn foreman also say — Therefore it is Considered by  
 the Justices here to wit at the Court House in the Town of Exeter in said  
 County on the third Tuesday in June being the fifteenth day of June Anno  
 Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty one That the said Joan Anderson  
 stand on the pillory for the space of half an hour and that afterwards  
 she receive at the public Whipping post Sixteen Lashes well laid on her  
 bare back till the blood ap<sup>r</sup>. and also pay the sum of five pounds of the value of the  
 goods of John being of the value of ~~two hundred~~ <sup>the sum of</sup> Six pounds <sup>amounting in</sup>  
 the whole to the sum of two hundred current money of the province aforesaid  
 being as a punishment for the Crime aforesaid. and also pay the sum of Six  
 hundred Sixty Seven pounds of Tobacco Est. accruing on the promise aforesaid  
 to the officers of this Court.

It is also Considered by the Court here at this day to wit the day and  
 year last mentioned that the Sheriff of this County take the said Joan  
 Anderson into his Custody and Execute the punishment in the Judgment  
 aforesaid and afterwards bring her into Court against of which  
 precept to wit Joseph Young Gent High Sheriff of this County  
 makes return on the day and year last said that he hath Executed  
 the punishment in the said Judgment and also that he hath here ready the  
 said Joan Anderson before the Court
