and Chattels Lands and Tenements Separately to be made and Leased
for the use of the said Lord Proprietor and Successors in Case that if the a
forenamed George Copper shall personally appear at our next County
Court to be held for Kent County the third Monday in June next and to
Answer unto such Matters as shall be objected against him by Elizabeth
Galloway of the said County concerning an assault and Battery lately
made upon the said Elizabeth Galloway by the above named George
Copper and concerning some other misdemeanors tending to the Breach
of the Peace and that if he do not depart without Leave of the Court
that then this Recognizance to be void otherwise to be and remain in
force and virtue taken and acknowledged before me JOHN EVANS

And now here at this Court to wit at the Court House in the Town of C^hest^r
in said County on the third Monday in June being the fiftenth day of
said Month Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred and thirty one Came
the afo^r George Copper and in his proper person appeared to the afo^r
Recognizance and prayed the same might be discharged. Ordered by the Court
here that the said Recognizance be discharged. Thereupon the afo^r
George Copper his Recognizance afo^r is discharged there being no
cause shown to the contrary also Nehemiah Powell's Recognizance
for the appearance of the afo^r George Copper is discharged &c

Ordered by the Court here that Joseph Francis Clerk of the said Court
of this Court exhibit an Information on the same assault ag^t the afo^r
George. which being accordingly done is as follow. Kent County B.
