Herein County Be it remembered that on the twenty eight day of May Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & thirty one William Pearce personally appeared before me one of the right Honourable the Lord Justices of the said County & Acknowledged him self Indebted to the said Lord Proply in the sume of twenty pounds Sterling to be levied on his Lands & tenement goods and Chattels Conditionally that if he doe and shall make the third Tuesday in June next & answer unto all such things as shall be objected against him on behalf of the said Lord Proply & in the meantime to keep the peace and be of good Behaviour to all his Lordships people then the recognizance to be void
