ordered by the Court here that the same Charles Smith enter into recogniz. for his appearance to next Court to answer unto the afo Information thereupon the same Charles Smith in his proper person now here at this Court came to wit at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in June being the fiftenth day of said Month Anno Domini 1731. hundred and thirty one and Acknowledged himself Indebted to the Right Hon. the Lord Propy. in the sum of ten thousand pounds of Tobacco to be paid to his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and Levied on his goods & Chattles Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if he the said Charles shall not make his personall appearance at the next Court to be hold for said County on the third Tuesday in August next then to answer unto afo said Information against him for Marrying out of the Province wherewith he Acknowledges himself Content And thereupon the same Information was continued untill next Court

of His Majesty's Indictment fornication The afo in her proper person appeared & pleaded not guilty & ordered by the Court here that Joane Anderson Surely be gave for her appearance to next Court to answer unto the afo Indictment at next Court Here
