suffer any Corporall punishment therefore but that
nevertheless he shall stand and be in the same plight
State and Condition to all intents and purposes as if the
said felony whereof he the said Phillimon Church hath
been convict had never been done or committed to wit
our Dear brother Bonduit Leonard Calvert Governour
and Commander in Chief in cover our said province of
Maryland this Thursday of August in the fiftenth
year of our Dominion & Annoy Done Sedule on lunde
-100 & twenty eight by protest of which Letters patent
of the said Lord prop^r the said Phillimon pleading the
said Letters patent pray that he of the of the p^rson
as by the Court here may be dismissed
The Court values the hogg in the Indictment to 200 Tobs
the four fold of which being Eight hundred pounds of
tobs forburn the value of the hogg
Ordered that he give ^{security for his} good behaviour for the space of three
monthes
