His Ship Jacob Perkins and John Turner at last Court ordered into Prison for the app^{ts} at this Court of the said John Foucher and now at this Court came the said John Foucher and appeared in his proper person ordered the same to be done Thereupon the same recognizance of the said Jacob Perkins and John Turner in the Sum of ten pounds each for the appear of the said John Foucher to this Court is here dispensed

His Ship Kent County Jo. The Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is for Kent County &c upon their Oath do present that Mary Davis late of Shrovesbury Parish in the County aforesaid Spinster the tenth day of April Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court did Commit Fornication with a certain person to the Jurors aforesaid unknown and did permit the same unknown person then and there to have carnal knowledge of her body and to beget then and there a Bastard Child on the body of her the said Mary to the high displeasure of Almighty God to the evil Example of all others in such case offending Contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government and against the Form of the Act of Assembly in that case made and provided
 Test Sam Wallace a true Bill Roger Huter Foreman

And the said Mary Davis in her proper person comes and Testifies that she cannot gainway the Indentment aforesaid against him brought in but that she is guilty of the fornication above upon her Imposed as by the said Indentment it is alleged and thereupon Submits to the Court Therefor it is Considered by the Justices here to wit at the Court House in the Town of Chertsey in said County on the third Wednesday in June being the fiftieth day
