Lordship . . . For as much as the aforesaid Jane hath confessed to the Indebtedness of a part
 as may ap^r to 17. The Court then ordered that she should give
 Security for appearance and good behav^r to the then next Court
 Thereupon came into Court Nathaniel Kennard husband of
 the aforesaid Jane and acknowledged himselfe Indebted to his Lordship the Right Hon.
 the Lord Proprietarie of this Province his heirs & Successors in the sum of ten
 pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to be levied on his goods and Chattels Lands
 and Tenements Conditionally that if the said Jane shall not make her personall
 appearance at the then next Court to be held for said County at the Court House in the
 Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November next and in the mean
 time she is to be of good behaviour wherewith he Acknowledges himselfe Content
