Bowles Green of Kent County Labourer at the day and
 year ap before the said John Evans Acknowledged
 himself indebted unto the Lord prop^{ty} of this Province
 of Maryland in the sum of twenty pounds Sterling money
 of Great Britain to be made and Secured &c. Conditionally

that if he should not make his personal appearance
 before the Justice of this Court to answer unto what
 shall be objected against him on his Lordship's behalf on
 suspicion of felony and if that in the mean time he should
 not be of good behaviour And now at this Court to wit the 20th
 day of August Anno Dom 1720 the said Bowles Green
 having appeared his recognizance is discharged —

Daniel Thum and Edward Rogers both of Kent County
 planters did present at the day the day and year ap before
 the said Mr. John Evans Acknowledged themselves indebted
 unto the Lord prop^{ty} of this Province of Maryland in the
 sum of ten pounds Sterling money each to be made and
 Secured &c. Conditionally that if the said Bowles Green
 should not make his personal appearance before the Justice
 of this Court to answer unto what shall be objected
 against him on his Lordship's behalf on suspicion of felony
 And if that in the mean time he should not be of good behav^r
 And now at this Court to wit the 20th day of August Anno Dom
 1720 the said Bowles Green having appeared the said
 Dan^l. Thum & Edward Rogers their recogⁿ is discharged —
