 Tuesday in Nov. next then & there to prosecute in behalf of his Ex. a
 certain William Chorom of W. C. for Beating & Whipping of him the said
 Mathias Day &c. then this recognizance to be void otherwise to remain in
 full force taken before me one of the Right Hon. the Lord Prop.
 Justices for Kent County ————— Geo. Sherwin

And now here at this Court to wit on the third Tuesday in Nov. being the
 sixteenth day of said Month Anno Domini 1731 came the sd Mathias
 Day and in his proper person appeared and prand the sd recognizance
 be deft. ordered by the Court here that the same be deft. Thereupon
 the same recognizance is by this Court deft. as Cause being shown to the
 contrary.

Mathias Day & Joseph Mann Sworn to by Grand Jury against same.
 and the Grand Jury returns a bill against the same sign a true bill
 of said W. C. for man. The sd William Chorom in his proper person
 appeared and pleaded not guilty &c. ordered that Surety be given for
 his appearance to answer the same at next Court.

The same William Chorom of Kent County Plaintiff came into Court in his
 proper person and acknowledged himself indebted to the Right Hon. the
 Lord Proprietor in the sum of ten pounds Sterling to be paid to his said
 Lord Ship his heirs and Successors to be made and levied on his body
 goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if the sd William
 Chorom shall not appear at next Court to be held for said County on the
 third Tuesday in March next to answer unto an Indictment found against
 him for an assault on Mathias Day in the mean time he is to be of good
 behav. where with he acknowledges himself content

at the same Court came Francis Barnog of Kent County Plaintiff
