 levied of his body goods & Chattels Lands & Tenements for the
 use of the said Lord property his heirs and assigns upon
 conditionall that if the same Thomas Clarke shall not
 make his personall appearance before the Justice of the same
 County Court at a Court to be held for said County at the Court
 house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday
 of August next ensuing to answer unto what shall there and there
 by the same Court or part of the said Lord property be objected

against him and that if in the mean time he shall not keep the peace and be of
 good behav^r & And also on the same fourteenth day of July William Burke and Stephen Myer
 came before me the said Justice and did severally acknowledge themselves to be respectively
 indebted unto the same Lord property in the sum of ten pounds Sterling money and each to
 be levied as afo^r for the use afo^r upon the same condition above specified of Henry Wans

and now here at the third Tuesday in Nov^r being the sixteenth day of said month Anno
 Domⁱ 1731 between thirty one same the afo^r Thomas Clark and in his proper person
 appeared to the afo^r Recognizance and prayed the same might be disp^d ordered by the
 Court here that the same be disp^d The same Recognizance of the afo^r Thomas
 Clarke is by this Court here discharged as also William Burke and Stephen
 Myer are also discharged by this Court
