Francis Bollar who being duly selected tryd and sworn to say the truth in the
premises upon their Oath do say Noah Hampton afo is not guilty of the dealing
and receiving from the afo Adam three half pence as above mentioned and by Robert
Dunn thereforeman all so say . . . Therefore it is considered by the

Justices here to wit at a Court held for the County at the Court House in the Town
of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November being the sixteenth day
of said Month Anno Dom^o Seventeen hundred and thirty one That the afo
Noah Hampton as to the afo ~~Information~~ Information it is alleged but that he
be therefrom acquit and go thereof without day &c. It is also considered by
the same Court that the afo Noah Hampton pay the sum of eight hundred
forty three pounds of Tobacco costs accruing on the premises afo to the
officers of this Court
