John Ingham is not guilty of altering the mark of the Log at and by Robert Dunn thereof foreman all so say Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at a Court hold for West County at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November being the sixteenth day of said month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty one that the said John Ingham as to the said Indulment goe thereof without day and that he be therefrom acquit also it is considered that the same John Ingham pay the sum of Nine hundred and Ninety one pounds of Tobacco costs accruing in the premises at to the officers.

The said John Ingham entered into recognizance in the sum of forty poundsterling with Philip Hammond and James Calder his Sureties 20 Novber last at last August Court being the third Tuesday and second day of said month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty one for the appearance of the same John Ingham to this Court being the third Tuesday of November and sixteenth day of said month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty one and now at the same day last mentioned came the said John Ingham and in his proper person appears to the said recognizance and prays that he and his Sureties may be discharged.
