propety doth give the Court here to understand and be informed that William Quiggold  
 late of S. Pauls parish in Kent County a planter with many others malefactors  
 to the same attorney unknown the twentieth month day of August Anno Domini one  
 thousand seven hundred twenty and nine with force and arms the close of Thomas  
 Ambrose of the same County planter called Quoon Chacton at the parish afd in  
 the County afd within the Jurisdiction of this Court did break and enter and  
 twenty pannels of a fence of his the said Thomas made with rails of the value  
 of one hundred pounds of tobacco then and there standing erected to inclose the  
 corn of him the same Thomas in the said close then growing then and there  
 did break pull down and bear away and the said corn of him the said Thomas  
 Ambrose in the said close then growing of the value of three thousand pounds  
 of tobacco with horses steers cows and Bulls then and there did eat up broad  
 down and consume to the great damage of the said Thomas Ambrose to the evil  
 and pernicious example of all other malefactors and ill disposed persons  
 in such case offending and against the peace of the said Lord propety his good  
 rule and Government Wherefore the afd attorney prayeth the advice of  
 the Court herein the premises for the said Lord propety and due process of  
 Law against the afd William in this part to give to answer to the said  
 Lord propety of and upon the premises &c

At the third Tuesday in March being the sixteenth day of said Month  
 Anno Domini seven hundred and thirty one the Grand Jury then made  
 a presentment of the Trespas afd signed Math<sup>r</sup> Howard for man  
 and the Court orderd an Information to be exhibited by the C<sup>th</sup> of  
 the Indulments of this Court on the same Trespas. and thereupon  
 the same was continued until the third Tuesday in June then next  
 to hold. At which said third Tuesday in June being the fifteenth day of  
 said Month Anno Domini seven hundred and thirty one came  
 the afd propety by his atty afd and the same William Quiggold in  
 his proper person appeared and prayd a further continuance  
 until the third Tuesday in August next and he hath it &c

At which said third Tuesday in August being the seventeenth  
 day of said Month Anno Domini 1732 the afd propety by his atty  
 afd prayd and the afd William Quiggold in his proper person  
 and prayd further leave to be continued until the third Tuesday  
 in Nov<sup>r</sup> next and it is granted &c
