Conditionally that if the said Joseph should not make his personal appearance before the Justices of the then next Nov. Court as an Ind^t against the said Walker Incestone on suspicion of Intended Murder wherewith the said Patrick Clark Acknowledge himself content -

His Lordship } Ordered by the Court that the said Mathias Keith & Mathias give good security for his appearance & good behaviour to Nov. Court. Thereupon also Peter Massey and Samuel Gooding both of Kent County planters and present heron in Court in their proper person
