Whereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of the County that he immediately cause to come here twelve or by whom who neither do to recognize it because as well as of which said propra of the said Sheriff to wit Joseph Young now here at this day to wit on the third Sunday in March being the twenty first day of said Month amounting Seventeen hundred and thirty one make return

that he hath here ready twelve as by his propra he was Commanded and now here afterwards to wit the day and year last mentioned came againe the afo the Sheriff the Lord propra by his atty and the said Mary Graham in her proper person and the Jurors of that Jury being impanelled and called the wife came

to wit Simon Wilmer Samuel Jobby Morgan Hart John Cooper Charles Griffith John Dorrisk William Simcocks Isaac Freeman Griffith Jones Thomas

Charidor John Downing & John Carle who being duly elected tryd and sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their Oath Do say Mary Graham is guilty of the felony above mentioned as the Jurors Indictes and by Simon Wilmer there foreman all to say. Therefore it is Considered

by the Justices here to wit the Sunday last mentioned That the afo Mary Graham for the afo felony found by the Jury at the said Court hath a fine of four in the pillory and receive on her bare back at the publick whipping post thirty one lashes well laid on till the blood appear and also pay the sum of Fifteen hundred and sixty pounds of Tobacco the four fold of the goods afo. And also it is Considered that she pay the sum of Six hundred

seventy six pounds of Tobacco costs Accruing on the premises afo to the officers of this Court And that Mr James Stout to whom the afo Mary is a servant pay the afo Charges as the Act of Assembly in such case lately made and provided directs

It is also Considered by this Court here to wit the Sunday last mentioned That the Sheriff of North County Court take the afo Mary Graham into his Custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment afo
