

Submits to the Court Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at a Court held for Kent County at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in March Being the twenty first day of said Month anno Domini Thousand hundred and thirty one That the afo William Body pay the sum of one hundred pounds of Tobacco to his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary &c as a fine for committing the assault afo inform afo Confort and also it is considered by the same Court the same day afo That the afo William Body pay the sum of four hundred and twenty three pounds of Tobacco rods — accruing on the premises afo to the officers of this Court *Sam Smith Esq.*

Nehemiah Powell and John Body at last November Court entered into recognizance in the sum of ten pounds Sterling each for the appearance of the afo William Body at this Court and to answer afo and be of good behaviour vi. The afo William Body in his proper person appears and prayeth that his liberty & Recognizance for his appear. may be discharged ordered by the Court here that the same Recognizances be discharged as perdy. This Court here on the third Monday in March being the twenty first day of said Month anno Domini Thousand hundred and thirty one Discharge the afo Nehemiah Powell and John Body's Recognizances as afo prayd more being no cause shown to the contrary

If His Majestys & Kent Countyes / The Juries for the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is for the Budge of Kent County afo upon their oaths William Chorom do present that William Horcom late of Stowbury parise in the County afo the Town of Stowbridge the last day of September anno Domini Thousand hundred and thirty and one at the parise and in the County afo within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon Mathias Day in the peace of God and of the said Lord Proprietary then and there being with force and arms an assault did make and vni the said Mathias then and there did beat wound and scelly treat so that of his life it was much disperced and other harme to him done and there did to the great damage of the said Mathias and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary his good rule and dignity he afo Mathias Day on the back of the afo Indenture was endorsed as folldw^r A true Bill & I am witness thereto — And the afo William Chorom in his proper person cometh and saith heal he is in no sort guilty of the premises above express vni imposed as by the afo Indenture it is alledged and thereof he putteth himself upon the Country afo Notwell stending the afo place where the afo William Chorom and with him drew his plea afo as by him above pleaded And now he cometh and saith heal he can not gainsay the Indenture afo so as afo against him brought up witness day but that he is guilty of the assault above upon him imposeth as by the afo Indenture it is alledged and thereupon submits to the Court Therefore it will be by the Justices here to wit at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in March on the twenty first day of said Month anno Domini thousand three
