Joseph Mann an Exor. in the above cause prooves he allowed six days ordered that the Sum William Chorom pay the sd Joseph Mann the Sum of one hundred and eighty pounds of Tobacco for six day Attendance as afd

The sd William Chorom at last November Court entered into recognizance in the Sum of ten pounds Sterl to appear at this Court to answer afd and also at the same Court Francis Barney entered into Recognizance in the Sum of ten pounds Sterl for the sd William Chorom's appearance at this Court to answer afd All now here at this Court to wit the third Tuesday in March being the twenty first day of said Month Anno Domini 1731 hundred and thirty one came the sd Wm Chorom and in his proper person appeared to the sd Recognizance and prayd he and his Surety might be discharged The Court here discharged the sd William Chorom's recognizance and the sd Francis Barney's recognizance there being no cause shown to the contrary

Joseph Mann at the sd Nov. Court as an Exor. ^{with afd cause} entered into recognizance in the Sum of five pounds Sterl for his appearance at this Court and also George Gleaves at the sd Nov. Court entered into Recognizance in the Sum of five pounds Sterl as Security for the sd Joseph Mann at this Court

All now here at this Court to wit on the third Tuesday in March being the twenty first day of said Month Anno Domini 1731 hundred and thirty one came the sd Joseph Mann and in his proper person appeared to the sd Recognizance and prayd he and his Surety might be disp'd The sd Joseph Mann and his Security as afd there Recognizances are by this Court here disp'd

Of the Sheriff of Kent County The Jurors for the right honourable the Lord Judge that now is for the body of Kent County upon their Oath do present that William Blake late of S. Pauls Parish in the County afd Labourer the tenth day of September Anno Domini 1731 hundred thirty one with force and Arm at the Parish afd in the County afd within the Jurisdiction of this Court one pair of breeches of the Value of one hundred pounds of Tobacco one Jacket of the Value of three hundred pounds of Tobacco two Shirts of the Value of one hundred pounds of Tobacco each one pair of Shoes of the Value of fifty pounds of Tobacco one wadded Cap of the Value of forty pounds of Tobacco and one pair of hose of the Value of forty pounds of Tobacco of the Goods and Chattels of William Socorby then and there being found therein there feloniously did steal take and bear away contrary to the Statute of the said Lord Judge his good rule and Government and against the Form of the Statute of Assembly in such case lately made and provided the sd Blake in his proper person cometh and saith that he cannot ~~guarantee~~ is in no sort guilty of the felony afd above upon him Imposed as by the afd Indictment it is alledged and thereof he putteth himself upon the Country
