 & James Moore who being duly & lawfully tryd and sworn to say the truth in the premises
 upon their Oath do say William Blake is guilty of the felony above mentioned
 as he stands indicted and by Samuel Jooey therefor man all do say therefore
 it is considered by the Justices here to wit at a Court hold for North County at
 the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third in March being
 the twenty first day of said month Anno Domini 1731 hundred and thirty one
 that the said William Blake ~~do~~ as a punishment for his Crime and by the verdict of
 the Jurors and found guilty he stand one hour in the pillory and then to have on
 his bare back thirty one lashes well laid on till the blood appear and pay the four
 fold of the said Goods which ^{amount} ~~amount~~ to the sum of two thousand nine hundred
 and twenty pounds of Tobacco &c. and also it is considered by the Court here
 that the said William Blake pay the sum of seven hundred and twenty three pounds
 of Tobacco cost and charges accrued on the premises and
 It is also considered by the Court here at this day to wit the day and year
 last mentioned that the Sheriff of North County take the said William Blake into his
 custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment and specified and afterwards to
 bring him into Court against of which precept to wit Joseph Young Gould
 Sheriff of North County makes return on the day & year last said that he hath
 executed the punishment in the Judgment and also hath here the said William
 Blake before the Court
