came and acknowledged themselves indebted to the right honourable the Lord
propety in the Sum of five pounds Sterling each to be paid to his said Lord King
his heirs and Successors and to be made and levied on their body good and
Chattell Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if the afo^d Daniel Flinn Jun^r
shall not appear and answer at next June Court as afo^d for his default
