It is remembered that on the Eleventh of this Instant April Anno Dom 1732 John Hankins and Isaac Froeman both of Thom County did acknowledge themselves justly indebted unto Right Honourable the sd people of the Province of Maryland in the Sum of twenty pounds Sterling money to be levied on their Body goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if a certain Richard Houghton of Cecil County in the Province of Do not make his personall appearance before the Justice of Thom County in the Province of the third Wednesday of June then and there to answer unto such matters and things as shall be objected against him concerning his Begitting a Bastard Child on the Body of a certain Sarah Boyer of the sd County and Do not Depart without Leave of the Court that then this recognizance taken before me to void otherwise to stand and Remain in full force

And now at this Court the sd third Wednesday in June being the twentieth day of said Month Anno Dom Seventeen hundred and thirty two came the sd Richard Houghton and in his proper person appeared to the sd Recognizance ordered by the Court here that the same be defid as prayed The sd John Hankins and Isaac Froeman there Recognizance was also are by this Court here defid there being no cause shown to the contrary

The Deposition of Sarah Boyer of Thom County in the Province of Maryland after being Legally Sworn on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God Deposeth that on the sixteenth day of May Anno Dom 1731 a certain Richard Houghton of Cecil County had carnal knowledge of her Body and then and there did Begitt a Bastard Child upon her Body and further saith not April 11. 1732 the above sworn to before me

It is remembered that on the 25 day of March 1732 Daniel Perkins appeared personally before me one of the Right Hon. the sd people Justice of the peace for y^e County of Kent and acknowledged himself to be justly indebted unto the sd people of this Province in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling to be levied on his body goods & Chattles Lands Tenements Conditionally if he shall make his personall appearance before the Justice of June Court next to be held for the County of Kent to give evidence on the sd Lordships behalf concerning an assault and battery or committed by a certain William Sidmarsh & in the mean time if he shall keep the peace & be of good behaviour then the sd Recognizance to be void & of now effect
