Thomas Marlaim Servant to M<sup>r</sup> William  
Nicholson being in Custody on Suspicion of Felony  
three months & two days & the Cost amount to 10<sup>l</sup> 5<sup>s</sup> —  
the Court Orders that he serve at the Expiration of his  
time for the time he hath been in Custody And the sd  
Tobacco the space of two years & three months Over &  
above his Indenture time And Ordered that he return to  
his Masters Service —
