

and at the third Tuesday in August being the fifteenth day of said month the said Information was continued until the third Tuesday in November then next ensuing & at which said third Tuesday in November came the said Margaret Jones and in her proper person appeared and the same Margaret saith that she cannot deny the Information and so as aforesaid against her exhibited nor but that she is guilty of the fornication aforesaid above upon her imposed as by the said Information is alleged and thereupon she submits to the Court. Therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November being the twenty first day of said month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty two That the said Margaret Jones receive at the public whipping post twenty lashes well laid on her bare back both the blood appear as a punishment for her crime of committing the fornication aforesaid in form aforesaid and also it is considered that the same Margaret Jones pay the sum of three hundred and twenty seven pounds of Tobacco costs accruing on the premises aforesaid to the officers of this Court and of James Smith Esq. It is also considered by the Court here at this day to wit the same day and year last mentioned That the Sheriff of Kent County take the said Margaret Jones into his custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment aforesaid specified and afterwards to bring her into Court again of which precept to wit John Gresham Esq. Sheriff of Kent County makes return on the day and year last mentioned that he hath executed the punishment in the Judgment aforesaid and also hath here the said Margaret before the Court. The same is ordered to give security for payment of the fees aforesaid thereupon came into Court Esq. Ebenezer Blackston of Kent County and promised to pay the fees to the officers of this Court for the said Margaret Jones and the same Margaret is from this time discharged &

of His Lordship. The said John entered into Recognizance on the 10th August 1732 before M. George Shivers one of His Lordships Justices of this Court in the sum of ten pounds Sterling for his appearance to August Court last on account of an assault by him made on a certain James Jones (as by the said Recognizance may appear in this Book fo 314). The same John with appearing at that Court the same was continued until this Court and now at this Court to wit on the third Tuesday in November being the twenty first day of said month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty two came the said John and in his proper person appeared to the same and prayed that his Recognizance might be discharged & ordered by the Court here that the same Recognizance be discharged. The same Recognizance is by this Court here discharged there being no cause shown to the contrary &
