Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling to be paid unto his Said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if the said James Thomas Jun^r shall appear at any time during this Courts sitting to Answer unto the said Indult^{ment} for committing fornication &c. and to be of good behaviour wherewith the said John Robinson acknowledges himself Content

after which came the said James Thomas Jun^r and appeared to the said Recognizance and prayd he might be therefrom discharged. Ordered by the Court here that the same Recognizance be discharged as prayd as also his Surety

The said Recognizance is by this Court here desist^d There being no cause shewⁿ to the contrary John Robinson who was Surety as afd his Recognizance is also discharged

Ordered by the Court here that the said James Thomas Jun^r enter into Recognizance for his appearance at next Court to Answer the said Indultment and that good Surety also be given

Whereupon the same James Thomas Junior of West County Planter and present here in Court in his proper person cometh and acknowledges himself indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling to be paid to his Said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and levied on his body Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if the same James Thomas shall not make his personall appearance at next Court to be held for said County on the third Tuesday in March ensuing to Answer unto a certain Indultment for committing fornication with a certain Anne Whitehead and that in the mean time he is to be of good behaviour wherewith he acknowledges himself to be Content

Also Benjamin Griffith and Harry Trulock both of West County Planters here present in their proper persons cometh and acknowledges themselves indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is in the Sum of five pounds Sterling each to be paid to his Said Lordship his heirs and Successors and to be made and levied on their bodies Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if the said James Thomas Jun^r shall not make his personall appearance at the next Court to be held for said County to Answer unto an Indultment of fornication which he the same committed with a certain Anne Whitehead and that in the mean time the same James Thomas is to be of good behaviour wherewith they acknowledge themselves to be therewith Content

Ordered by the Court here that Anne Whitehead give Security for her appearance at next Court as an Ind. against the said James Thomas Jun^r
