

November Court 1732

Seventeen hundred and thirty two at the parish and in the County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon John Gamboll in the peace of God and of the said Lord properly then and there being with force and arms an assault did make and him the said John Gamboll therein there did beat wound and evilly treat so that of his life it was much endangered and other harms to him then and there did to the great damage of the said John Gamboll and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary his good rules and dignity &c.

The same Judgment was endorsed At true bill of James Moore Foreman and the said James Hagan in his proper person cometh and saith that he cannot gainsay the Judgment and so as against him brought nor can he say but that he is guilty of the assault above upon him imposed as by the said Judgment it is alleged and thereupon submits to the Court Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here to wit at the County Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November being the twenty first day of said Month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty two That the said James Hagan pay the sum of One hundred pounds of Tobacco as a fine for committing the assault and in form of Confess also it is Considered that the said James Hagan pay the sum of two hundred and twenty eight pounds of Tobacco costs accruing on the premises and to the officers of this Court.

Memorandum that on the day of October Anno Domini 1732 personally appeared before me John Evans one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County James Hagan of the said County planter and did acknowledge himself to owe and stand justly indebted unto the Right Honourable the said proprietor of this Province in the sum of ten pounds Sterling money of his goods and Chatter Lands and Tenements to be made and conveyed to the use of the said Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors in case the above bound James Hagan shall not make his personal appearance at the next County Court to be held for that County the third Tuesday in November next and to answer unto such Matters and things as shall be then and there objected against him by John Gamboll concerning an assault lately made upon the said John Gamboll by the above bound James Hagan and if he do not depart without leave of the Court then this recognizance to be void otherwise to be and remain in Force and Virtue

And now here at this Court to wit on the third Tuesday in November being the twenty first day of said Month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty two and appeared to the said Recognizance and prayed the same might be discharged ordered by the Court here that the same Recognizance be discharged as prayed The said James Hagan Recognizance is by this Court here discharged there being no cause shown to the contrary &c.

The County of Be it Remembered that on the tenth day of October Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty two Samuel Norris of the said County Planter personally appeared before me one of his Lordships the Lord Justices
