And now here at the third Monday in November being the twenty first day of  
 said Month 1732 is ordered by the Court that the afd Procuqiance be discharge  
 and the afd Samuel Morris's afd Procuqiance taken care of for the  
 appearance of the afd James Hagan is by this Court here discharged there  
 being no cause shown to the contrary

That County Jrs. The Jurors for the right Honourable  
 His Lordship the Lord propty that now is for the body of Kent County afd  
 upon their oath do present that John Gambell late of St.  
 Pauls parish in the County afd Planter the tenth day of  
 October Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred thirty and two at the parish afd in the  
 County afd within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon Samuel Morris in the peace  
 of God and of the Said Lord proprietary then and there being with force and Arms  
 an assault did make and thus the Said Samuel then and there did beat wound and  
 evilly treat so that of his life it was much despaired and other harms to him  
 then and there did to the great damage of the Said Samuel and against the  
 peace of the Said Lord proprietary his good rule and dignity &c

The Same Indulment was evidenced as follows by a true bill of James Moore foreman  
 And now here at this Court came the afd John Gambell in his proper person and shewt  
 that he cannot gainsay the Indulment afd so as afd against him brought nor but  
 that he is guilty of the assault afd as by the afd Indulment it is alledged and  
 thereupon he submits to the Court Therefore it is considered by the Justices  
 here to wit at the County Court House in the Town of Chester in Said County on the  
 third Monday in November being the twenty first day of said Month Anno Domini  
 thousand seven hundred and thirty two That the afd John Gambell pay the Sum  
 of two hundred pounds of Tobacco to the Said Lordship the Lord proprietor as a fine  
 for committing the assault afd in form afd Content also it is considered by  
 the Justices afd That the Said John Gambell pay the Sum of one hundred and  
 eighty four pounds of Tobacco costs accruing on the promises afd to the officers  
 of this Court

That County Jrs. Be it Remembered that on the tenth day of October Anno  
 Domini 1732 thousand seven hundred and thirty two John Gambell of the Said  
 County Planter personally appeared before me one of his Lordships the Lord propty  
 Justices of the Said County and acknowledged himself to stand indebted to the Said Lord  
 Ship his heirs and Successors in the Sum of twenty pounds Sterling money of great  
 to be levied on the Lands and Tenements goods and Chattels Conditionally that if he  
 do not make his personall appearance at the next Court to be hold for the Said  
 County
