 on their bodies goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally if the  
 said William Booth shall not make his personall appearance at the next  
 Assizes and Goal Delivery to be held for the said County then and there to answer  
 unto what shall be objected against him on the Lordships behalf of and concerning  
 his uttering and paying away of false and Counterfeit money for current money of  
 this Province to a certain William Dellan of Chester Town Barber and in the mean  
 time the same William Booth is to be of good behaviour wherewith the same  
 James Gallaway and John Astley acknowledged themselves Content

Ordered by this Court here that a certain James Pichard enter into  
 Recognizance for his appearance as aforesaid against the said Court

 Booth wherewith he acknowledges himself Content At the same
