 him into Court againe of which precept to wit John Guestham Gentle  
 Sheriff of Kent County makes return on Tuesday and year last said  
 that he hath executed the punishment in the Judgment aforesaid and also hath  
 brought the said John Gold before the Court

Ordered by this Court that the aforesaid Master pay the fees accruing  
 on the premises aforesaid to the officers of this Court.

Ordered by this Court that the Clarke of this Court make out Summons for  
 such Evidence as the Clarke of Judgments of the same Court shall see  
 fit to do

On an arrant from Ed Benjamin Pearce one of the  
 Justices of Kent County on an Oath of Robert Howell  
 James and his wife that they had a Mollatto Child  
 from the aforesaid Phebe This Court thereupon orders

a warrant to take the same Phebe to answer the same The same  
 warrant being made out and the Sheriff of Kent County returns that  
 he hath the same Phebe as by the same warrant is Comanded

The aforesaid Phebe in her proper person appears This Court  
 orders that she give Security to answer unto what shall be objected ag<sup>st</sup>  
 her on her Lordships behalf. and thereupon the same Phebe Johnson  
 in her proper person acknowledges herself Indebted to the Right hon<sup>ble</sup>  
 the Lord Proprietary in the sum of five pounds sterling to be paid to the  
 said Lord Ship his heirs and Assignes ~~in the sum of~~ conditionally that if  
 she shall not appear every term during this Courts sitting to answer unto  
 what shall be objected against her on her Lordships behalf and in the  
 mean time she is to be of good behaviour wherefore she acknowledges  
 her self Content
