Personally appeared before me the Subscriber one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for Kent County Samuel Holyday and acknowledged himself indebted to the right Honourable the Lord propy in the Sum of two pounds sterl money of great Brittain to be Levied on his Lands and Tenements goods and Chattels conditionally that if he do not make his personall appearance at the next County Court to be hold at the Town of Choptan in said County and the mean time to be of good behaviour wherewith he is contented At which time came Roger Murphoy and acknowledged himself indebted unto his Lordship in the sum of two pounds sterl money of great Brittain to be Levied as aforesaid conditionally that if the said Samuel Holyday do not make his personall appearance as aforesaid Where with he is contented taken before me
