Cousins Jun. that he the said Edward shall personally appear before his Lordship's Justices of the said Lordship's Court to be hold at New Town in the said County on the third Wednesday in March next to do and undergo what shall then and there be enjoined him by the Court and that in the mean time he shall keep the peace towards our said Lord Proprietor and all his people and principally towards a certain Thomas Woods of the County aforesaid that is to say that he shall not do nor cause to be done either by himself or others any damage or molestation to the body of the said Thomas
