The said Edward Coffin junr in the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling is by this Court here discharged there being no cause shown to the contrary. Robert Green and John Dooonick his Surety in the sum of ten pounds Sterling are by this Court also discharged

Conditionally that if the said Abraham Lake do make his personal appearance before his Lordships Justices of his said Shipp's Court to be held at new Town for the said County on the third Tuesday in May next to give in Evidence in behalf the said Lord prop<sup>r</sup>. against a certain Edward Coffin in an assault made on the Body of Elizabeth Airos Then the above Recognizance to be void otherwise to stand in force
