AND the said Elleanor Ogelby in her proper person comes and saith that she cannot gainsay the Judgment aforesaid as against her brought nor but that she is guilty of the premises above upon her imposed as by the aforesaid Judgment it is alleged and thereupon submits to the Court Therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit at Kent County at the Court House in the Town of Chatham in said County on the Wednesday in June being the nineteenth day of said Month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three That the said Elleanor Ogelby pay the Sum of thirty Shillings current money as a fine to the use of the City for Committing the fornication aforesaid in form aforesaid and also pay the Sum of three hundred twenty five pounds of Tobacco costs accruing on the premises aforesaid to the officers of this Court ordered by this Court that the said Elleanor Ogelby be committed for the fine aforesaid AND that John Gresham Gould Sheriff of said County keep the said Elleanor until the aforesaid fine be paid. is ordered by this Court that the said Elleanor Ogelby be committed
