Ordered by this Court that Tomke Francis Gould Clerk of the
Judicature of this Court Declared an Information against the aforesaid John
Prosser the Person that Elizur Prosser proved to be the begotter of her
bastard Child.

If His Lordship's Command was given on the twenty eighth day
of March anno Domini one thousand seven hundred
and thirty three to the Sheriff of this County —

Martha Tippott aforesaid and thirty three to the Sheriff of this County —
that he take Martha Tippott late of Throsbury Parish in the County of
Suffolk of the Town of Throsbury and from thence keep so —
that she have her body before the Justices of our next County Court
to be held at our Court House in the Town of Chelmsford in said County on the
third Tuesday in June next and answering to answer unto a Coram Indictio
in our said Court for committing Prosecution with a certain Negro person and did
permit the said unknown person to have general knowledge of her body —
and to begot a bastarded Mollatto Child &c And that the Sheriff have
at the said Court the sum of £ 100.

At a weekly Court to be held County at the Court House in the
Town of Chelmsford in said County on the third Tuesday in June being the thirtieth
day of said Month anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty
three being the day of return of said Writ Comma fons Gresham
Gould Sheriff of said County and made return to the Court here
henceforward as follows by Elizur Prosser & John Gresham
Hath ready for the Juries for the Regt Honorable the Lord
Proprietary that was or for their family as upon their oaths
proposed that Martha Tippott late of Throsbury Parish in
the County aforesaid the tenth day of June anno Domini
Seventy four hundred thirty two at the parish aforesaid in the
County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court did commit
Prosecution with a certain Negro person to the Juries aforesaid unknown
