tionally that a certain Laughlan O'Brien do not make his personal
appearance at the next Court to be hold for the said County and answer
unto an assault and Battery on a certain Henry Evans Gould one of the
Justices of the Said County and in the mean time to keep the peace and
be of good behav. this this Recognizance to be void otherwise to
stand be and remain in full force power and virtue in Law.

At which said Court was at Kent County at the Court House in the
Town of Chester in said County on the Thursday in June in the ninth
with day of June Anno Domini one thousand Seven Hundred and thirty
three came the said Laughlan O'Brien and in his proper person
appeared to the said Recognizance and prayed that the same
might be dispensed and his Sureties recognizance for his appearance
be dispensed also. ORDERED by this Court that the said Recognizance
as aforesaid Laughlan O'Brien his recognizance as aforesaid taken
in the Sum of thirty pounds Sterling as aforesaid by this Court here
dispensed there being no cause shown to the contrary &c.

Whereas Powell his recognizance as aforesaid taken in the Sum of
twenty pounds Sterling for the appearance of the said Laughlan
O'Brien &c. and to answer as aforesaid. The said Recognizance is by this
Court here dispensed there being no cause shown to the contrary &c.

of St. Pauls Parish in the County of Kent the tenth day of April Anno Domini

the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Henry Evans Gould in
the peace of God and of the said Lord Prop^{ty} then and there being with
force and Arms compassed & made and him the said Henry Evans Gould
there did beat wound and evilly treat so that of his life it was
much endangered and other harms to him then and there did to
