which is granted. And the same Cause is continued untill the same third Tuesday in  
March next ensuing &c.

And which said third Tuesday in March being the twentieth day of said Month  
Amounted One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two Cams the said Lord Propy  
By his atty and the same James Thomas Jun. in his proper person and prays  
the same Cause may be continued untill the third Tuesday in June then next  
ensuing which is granted &c.

And which said third Tuesday in June being the nineteenth day of said Month  
Amounted One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three Cams the said Lord  
Propy By his atty and the same James Thomas Jun. in his proper person  
and prays the same Cause may be continued untill the third Tuesday in August  
then next ensuing which is granted &c.

And which said third Tuesday in August being the twentieth day of said  
Month Amounted One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three Cams the said  
Lord Propy By his atty and the same James Thomas Jun. in his proper  
person and prays that he may have Liberty to withdraw his plea and  
and now here at the said Court the same day last mentioned came the  
said James Thomas Jun. and said that he with standing his plea and  
said that he cannot gain say the Judgment of the said Court against him  
brought in but that he is guilty of the prosecution above upon him imposed  
as by the said Judgment it is alleged and thereupon submits to the  
Court. Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit the same  
day and Year last mentioned that the said James Thomas Jun. pay the

Sum of thirty Shillings Current money of the Province and as fine for the  
use of the County for committing the fornication and in fine and costs  
and also pay the Sum of eight hundred and nine  
pounds of Tobacco costs Arising on the premises and to the Officers of  
this Court.

Ordered by this Court that the fine and be immediately delivered to the  
Sheriff of Montserrat upon which John Gresham Gould Sheriff of the  
County comes into Court and Acknowledges the Receipt of the said fine.

Ordered by this Court that Security be given for the said James Smith the  
Thereupon Jeremiah Covington of Montserrat planter and present here  
in Court in his proper person and Acknowledges himself indebted to the said Court  
the same County Court to wit James Smith the loss belonging to him  
arising on the premises and which amounts to the Sum of three  
hundred ninety three pounds of Tobacco wherewith the same Jerome  
Covington Acknowledges himself therewith to be Content.
