

By His Lordship's Command was given on the twenty fifth day of June Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three To the Sheriff of West County that he take Rachel Dowlin late of Shrovsbury parish in the County aforesaid Spinster if she should be found in his bailiwick and her safe keep so that she have her body before the Justices of our most Excellent Majesty at our Court House in the Town of Chester in Said County on the third Tuesday in August then next to answer unto a certain Judgment for committing fornication with a certain unknown person and did permit the same unknown person to have carnal knowledge of her body and to beget then and there a bastard Child &c. And that the same Sheriff have at the said Court the same writ &c.

At which said third Tuesday in August being the twenty first day of said Month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three being the day of return of said writ came John Grosham Esquire Sheriff of said County and made return to the Court here thereof ordered as follows by the Court &c.

The Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor that now is for West County aforesaid upon their Oath do present that Rachel Dowlin late of Shrovsbury parish in the County aforesaid Spinster the tenth day of August Anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty two at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornication with a person to the Jurors aforesaid unknown and did permit the same unknown person then and there to have carnal knowledge of her body and to beget then and there a bastard Child on the body of her the said Rachel to the high Displeasure of Almighty God to the evil Example of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietor that now is his good rule and Government and against the form of the Act of Assembly in that Case made and provided

The same Judgment was ordered as follows by Bulla Vera William Wilmer Foreman

At the third Tuesday in March being the twentieth day of said Month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred thirty two the aforesaid Judgment was continued until the third Tuesday in June then next ensuing &c.

At which said third Tuesday in June being the nineteenth day of said Month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three the said Lord Proprietor by his attorney aforesaid and the said Rachel not appearing the same is ordered to be continued until the third Tuesday in August then next ensuing &c. which was found as aforesaid
