of His Majesty } Maryland, Be it remembered that on the 20th July 1733 Daniel Ferrell of the County of Prince Georges acknowledged himself indebted unto the said Nathaniel Hyson of the County of Maryland his heirs and Successors ten pounds Sterling to be Levied on his Body goods & Chattels Lands & Tenements Conditionally if a certain Nathaniel Hyson Son of the said Nathaniel Hyson of said County deceased doth not make his personal appearance before the Justices of the Upper Court to be held at Chester Town in Kent County the third Tuesday of August next then & there to answer to such matters as shall be objected against him the said Nathaniel Hyson by a certain John English of said County concerning the said Nathaniel's Horse Whipping of the said John &c. and in the mean time that the said Nathaniel be of the good behaviour and do not depart the Court without Licence till this Recognizance be void otherwise he shall remain in Jail & be whipped taken & acknowledged before me one of the said Lord Propriety Justices for said County Geo Sherwin

and what said third Tuesday in August being the twelfth day of said month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came the said Nathaniel Hyson and appeared and prayed the aforesaid recognizance be discharged. ordered by this Court here that the aforesaid Recognizance be defied as prayed.

Daniel Ferrell aforesaid his recognizance taken in the sum of ten pounds Sterling for the appearance of the said Nathaniel Hyson is by this Court here defied.

John English, William Blackston, Morgan Huff and William Graves are sworn to the Grand Jury against the said Nathaniel Hyson aforesaid.

the Grand Jury returns an Indictment against the said Nathaniel Hyson for assaulting John English &c. ordered by this Court that Surety be given for the appearance of the said Nathaniel Hyson to answer the aforesaid Indictment at next Court being the third Tuesday in November next ensuing.
