Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County that he immediately cause to come here twelve by whom he is to be sworn to recognize the said because as well as of which said process the said Sheriff to wit John Gresham Gould now here at this day to wit on the third Tuesday in August being the twenty first day of said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty three makes return that he hath here ready to do as he is by his process he was commanded and now here afterwards to wit the day and year last mentioned came again the said Lord proptly by his attorney and said the said James Toas in the proper person and the Jurors of that Jury being impanelled and called Likewise came to wit John Tilden Stephen Glanville Thomas Spiner George Medford Richard Heselman George Vansant Joshua Sanford Thomas Whitt John Brown Robert Libby William Hyson & Samuel Becke who being duly elected by and sworn to say the truth in the promises upon their oaths do say James Toas was guilty as above by the Judgment and is set forth and by John Tilden there fore: man all to say. The said James Toas having heard the verdict of the Jurors and against her and being asked if she had any thing to offer why Judgment should pass against her on the verdict of the Jurors and to what she answered that she had nothing to offer to the contrary — Therefore it is considered by the Justices

here to wit at Kent County at the Court house in the Town of Chatham in said County on the third Tuesday in August being the twenty first day of said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty three that James Toas and stand in the pillory the space of one quarter of one hour and to have at the whipping post on her back twelve lashes with the blood appear as a punishment for committing the felony and according to the force form and effect of the verdict and also it is considered that the said James Toas pay the sum of seven hundred and ^{twenty} seven pounds of tobacco costs accruing on the premises and to the officers of this Court. It is also considered by the Court here at this day to wit the day and year last mentioned that John Gresham Gould Sheriff of Kent County take the said James Toas into his custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment and specified and afterwards to bring her into Court again of which process
