 The afo^d Deed as afo^d ordered the afo^d Recog^d to be seal'd by Palmer Will Pott
 his Recog^d taken up to by him selfe as afo^d being shown to the afo^d Will Pott
 Benjamin Palmer and Robert Speer Sworn to the Grand Jury afo^d

Hert County Esq^r. The Jurors for the Right hon^{eble} the Lord Proprety
 that now is for Hert County afo^d upon their Oath do present that Dennis
 Long late of Shrewsbury Parish in Hert County afo^d Labourer the Servant
 of Benjamin Palmer the tenth day of July anno Domini Seventeen
 hundred thirty three at the parish afo^d in the County afo^d within the
 Jurisdiction of this Court with force and arms one Horse of a whist
 Colour of the price of Nine hundred pounds of tobacco of his goods.
 and Chattles of Robert Speer then and there being found then & there
 feloniously did Steal take and ride away contrary to the peace of the said
 Lord Proprety his good rule and Government and against the form of the Act
 of Assembly in such case made and provided Attest^d Ex^d par^d
 Tis Benjamin Palmer Robert Speer
 on the same Bill of Indictment was endorsed afo^d True Bill by Simon
 Wilmer foreman

Whereupon the afo^d Dennis Long in his proper person cometh and saith that
 he is no sort guilty of the premises above upon him Imposed as by the afo^d
 Indictment it is alledged and thereof to putte himself upon the County

and so, who fellooeth for the Lord Proprety in like manner saith he is guilty^d Proprety
 Whereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Hert County that he immediately
 cause to come here twelve d^r. By whom L^e who neither N^t is Recogniz^d to be
 as well s^r. Of which said precept the said Sheriff to wit John Graham Gould,
 now here at this day to wit the twenty first day of August anno Domini One
 thousand Seven hundred and thirty three makes return that he hath here
 ready twelve d^r. As by his precept he was commanded and now here after
 wards to wit the day & year last mentioned came again the afo^d Dennis Long
