 Proprietary doth give the Court here to understand and be informed that Thomas
 Hoborn late of Shrewsbury Parish in this County and Labourer the Seventeenth
 day of March anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty and one at the Parish aforesaid in
 the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court having been duly admonished
 by the Vestrymen of the said Parish afterward to wit the tenth day of June
 anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty and two and divers other times
 as well before as since the aforesaid Seventeenth day of March at the parish aforesaid in
 the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid did frequent the Company of
 a certain Rosemond Thompson of the Parish and County aforesaid contrary
 to the Act of Assembly in that case made and provided and against the peace
 of the said Lord Proprietary in good rule and Government wherefore his said
 attorney of the said Lord Proprietary prayeth the advice of the Court here in
 the premises and due process of Law in this part to be made against the aforesaid
 Thomas Hoborn to answer to the said Lord Proprietary of and upon the premises

 Seven hundred and thirty three makes return that he hath here before Gresham Esq
