said Lord Proprietor in this part pursuant to the death some Parents Kent County
Court before William Freckley Esq. and his associates his said Lordships Justices of
the said County Court to wit at Chester Town in the County of the twelfth day
of March Anno Domini seven hundred thirty three and for the said Lord
Proprietor doth give the Court here to understand and be informed that Thomas
Heborn late of Stewsbury Parish in the County of Labour the Seventh
day of March Anno Domini seven hundred thirty one at the parish aforesaid
the County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court having been duly admonished
by the Vestrymen of the said Parish afterword to wit the tenth day of June
Anno Domini seven hundred thirty two and at divers other times
as well before as since the aforesaid Seventh day of March at the parish aforesaid in
the County and within the Jurisdiction and did frequent the Company of
a certain Person named Thompson of the parish and County aforesaid in contravention
to the Act of assembly in that case made and provided and against the peace
of the said Lord Proprietor his good rule and Government wherefore the said
attorney of the said Lord Proprietor prayeth the advice of the Court here in
the premises and due process of Law in this part to be made against the said
Thomas Heborn to answer to the said Lord Proprietor of and upon the premises
aforesaid

seven hundred and thirty three makes return that he hath here ready Twelve
&c. as by his precept he was Commanded and now here afterword to wit the
