 the said Lord Proprietor

And the said Joseph Thompson in her proper person cometh  
 and saith that she is in no sort guilty of the premises above  
 upon her imposed as by the said Information it is alleged and sheweth  
 she putteth herself upon the Country

And he who followeth for the said Proprietor in like manner saith  
 she is guilty

And the said Thomas Francis attorney of the said Lord Proprietor  
 in Court cometh and with the advice of the Court saith that for as much  
 as he hath not Evidence sufficient to maintain the said Charge in the  
 Information aforesaid against the said Joseph Thompson he will  
 not prosecute the same Information any further therefore it is considered  
 by the Justices here to wit at their Court at the Court House in the Town  
 of Chester in said County on the third day of November being the Twentieth  
 day of said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty three  
 that the said Joseph Thompson as to the Information aforesaid do go without  
 without day and be therefrom acquitted also it is considered that the  
 said Joseph Thompson pay the Sum of Six hundred eighty Nine  
 pounds of Tobacco to the accruing on the premises aforesaid to the officers of  
 this Court

ordered by this Court here that Secordy be given for the said  
 Whereupon Thomas Heborn of Kent County Juror and present in  
 Court in his proper person cometh and acknowledged himself indebted  
 to the several officers of this Court the Sums accruing on the premises  
 aforesaid to the Sum of Six hundred eighty Nine pounds of Tobacco.
