And now here at this Court to wit at New County at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November being the twentieth day of said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty three Came the said Edpropy by his attorney and prayed that the said John Howell might be the defendant and Enforcer and the same John Howell in his proper person cometh and saith that he cannot gainsay the Judgment aforesaid as aforesaid against him brought nor but that he did the formation aforesaid by the said Judgment it is alleged and thereupon submits to the Court. Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at New County aforesaid the same day and year last mentioned that the said John Howell do find the sum of thirty Shillings current money of the province aforesaid to the use of the said County according to act of assembly in such case lately made and provided. Also it is considered by the same Justices that the said John Howell pay the sum of two hundred eighty five pounds of Tobacco Cash amounting on the premises aforesaid to the officers of this Court in

Likewise at the same time came Daniel Ferrill and Thomas Mahan both of New County planters and present in their proper persons before me and acknowledged themselves indebted to the Right Hon. the Lord Propy of the province aforesaid in the sum of five pounds sterling each to be made and payed on their body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the said Pharo Mingo shall not make his personall appearance at the next Court to be hold for said County at the Court House on the third

Tuesday in November then next ensuing to answer unto a certain Felony for stealing one pen knife and one pair of buttons the goods and Chattels of a certain John Galleghan and in the mean time he is to be of good behaviour whosoever they acknowledge them selves each of them to be content with
