His Lordship's Court remembered that on the twenty seventh of this
Instant August 1733 Henry Spencer did acknowledge
Jane Flanagan himself in Debt unto the Right Honourable the
Lord Propriety of the Province of Maryland his
Heirs and Successors in the Sum of twenty Pounds Sterling Money
of Great Britain to be Levied on his Goods and Chattels Lands and
Tenements Conditionally that if the Certain Jane Flanagan of
the said County do not make her personall Appearance before the
Justice of his Lordships Court for Kent County the third Tuesday of
November then and there to answer all such matters and things as shall
be objected against her Concerning her suffering her self to be gotten with
Child by a Certain Larrance heale of the said County and do not Depart
with out Leave of the Court that then this Recognizance taken before
me to be Void Otherwise to stand and remain in full force

And now here at this Court to wit at Kent County at the Court house in
the town of Gosport in said County on the third Tuesday in Novem-
ber the twentieth Day of said month Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred
& thirty three Came the said Jane Flanagan in her Proper person Appeared
and prayed her Sureties Recognizances might be Discharged Ordered
by the Court here that the said Henry Spencer Recognizances as aforesaid
Discharged as Prayed Henry Spencer and his Recognizances taken as aforesaid
is by this Court here Discharged each of them as prayed there being no
Cause shown to the contrary &c

August of 27 1733 Kent County for The Deposition of Jane Flanagan of
the said County being sworn on the Holy Evangelis of Almighty God
Deposeth that a Certain Larrance heale of the said County had Carnel
Knowledge of her body and did begett a bastard Child and further saith
not Sworn to before me the Subscriber - G. Wilson

The Grand Jury returned a bill of Indulment against the said Jane and
thereupon the same Indulment was read until next Court being the
third Tuesday in March

Ordered by this Court that Surety be given for the Appearance
of the said Jane thereupon Came Henry Spencer of Kent County Plumber
and appeared in Court in his proper person Acknowledged himself Indebted to
The Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietarie of this Province of Maryland to
