

The nineteenth day of said Month Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came the said Goodday Turner and in her proper person appeared and said that she cannot gain any the Judgment of so as she against her brought nor can she say but that she is guilty of the premises above upon her inposed as by the said Judgment it is alleged and thereupon submits to the Court and therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit the same day and Year last mentioned that the said Goodday Turner to have on her bare back of fifteen lashes well laid on her bare back till the blood appear as a punishment for committing the offence aforesaid in form aforesaid and also pay the sum of Three hundred and Eleven pounds of Tobacco cost arising on the premises to the officers of this Court

It is also considered by the Justices aforesaid the same day and Year aforesaid that John Gresham Gentle Sheriff of Kent County take the said Goodday Turner into his Custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment aforesaid and afterwards to bring her into Court againe of which precept to wit John Gresham Gentle Sheriff of Kent County makes return on the day and Year last said that he hath executed the punishment in the Judgment aforesaid and also hath here the said Goodday Turner before the Court

ordered by this Court here that the same Goodday Turner give Surety for the fees to the officers of this Court according on the premises aforesaid. Thereupon John Gamble of Kent County Gentle present in Court in his own person came and acknowledged himself indebted to the Right Hon. the said Court in the sum of One Thousand pounds of Merchantable Tobacco to be made and levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors Conditionally That if he shall not pay and satisfy unto the severall officers of this Court the fees by them charged according on the premises aforesaid wherewith he acknowledges himself content

of His Lord Ship Henry Spencer of Kent County planter at last November Court held for the same County entered into Recognizance for the appearance of the said Jane Flanningham at this Court to answer unto an Indictment of fornication at this present Court. And now here at this Court to wit at Kent County Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in March being the nineteenth day of said Month Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came the said Jane Flanningham and appeared in her proper person and prayed the said Recognizance taken for her appearance as aforesaid to be discharged ordered by this Court here that the said Recognizance be discharged as prayed. Henry Spencer's Recognizance taken as aforesaid in the sum of ten pounds
