 same Lord Propy prays the advice of the Court here in the premises and that due pro-  
 ceeds of Law in this part against the said John Hall may be made to answer unto the  
 same Lord Propy of and upon the premises &c. - Francis

And now here at the said Court to wit at West County at the Court House in the  
 Town of Chester in said County on the third tuesday in March being the nineteenth day

 Lord Propy by Josiah Francis his attorney and the same John Hall in his proper  
 person and the same atty of the said Propy prays that the said John Hall may

 be fined the sum of five hundred pounds of Tobacco for the use of his Majesty  
 as a fine for committing the offense aforesaid in form aforesaid avoiding to act of  
 assembly in such case lawfully made and provided &c. And also pay the  
 sum of three hundred and two pounds of Tobacco cost accruing to the officers  
 of this Court on the premises aforesaid
