 Court did commit Fornication with a certain Jane Flanagan and of her body then and there
 had carnal knowledge and a bastard Child on the body of her the same Jane then and
 there did begot to the high displeasure of Almighty God to the evil example of all others
 in such case offending contrary to the grace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is
 his good rule and Government and against the Form of the act of Assembly in such
 case lately made and provided in
 Francis

Test Jane Flanagan

On the back of the same was indorsed as follows viz by me John Dunn Juror
 and now here at this Court at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on
 the third day of March being the nineteenth day of said Month anno domini
 the said Noale by his atty and the said Flanagan by her atty and prayed the said Noale
 might be the Indulment of answer — and the said Laurence Noale in his proper
 person appeared and said that he cannot gain say the Indulment as to as against
 him brought nor can he say but that he is guilty of the fornication above upon him
 imposed as by the said Indulment it is alleged and thereupon submitted to the Court
 therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit the same day and year
 last mentioned that the said Laurence Noale do find the Sum of thirty Shillings
 current money as a fine for committing the offence of fornication and in force
 of Confess. and also pay the Sum of Forty four hundred fifty six pounds of
 Tobacco Cash amounting on the premises to the officers of this Court

ordered by this Court that John Grosheam Gent. Sheriff of said County who being
 present in Court keep the said Laurence Noale in safe Custody until the fees
 shall be paid thereupon is committed

ordered by this Court that the same John Grosheam being present in Court
 keep the said Laurence in safe Custody until he shall give Security with two
 Justices to keep the County harmless from any charge that may accrue due any
 ways chargeable to the County

whereupon Laurence Noale of Kent County ss. Cantor and acknowledged himself
 indebted to the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Propy in the Sum of 1000 thousand pd.
 of Tobacco to be made and Levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Ten-
 ements by the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors Conditionally
 that if the said Laurence shall not keep the County harmless and indemnified
 from any charge that may accrue by means of the Child that was delivered
 of Jane Flanagan of which he Confess to be the Beggetter and wherewith he
 acknowledges himself content
