 and Charged on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord:
 Ship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the same Mary Spearman shall not
 appear at any time during this Courts sitting to answer unto what shall be objected
 her on his said Ships behalf on account of her feloniously Stealing the goods and Chattels
 of the same Margaret Shipping and in the mean time she is to be of good behavior where:
 with she Acknowledges herself Content

Ordered by this Court that John Wright jun. enter into recognizance for his appearance any
 time this Court as an evidence against the said Mary Spearman. Thereupon the same John
 Wright jun. of Kent County planter in his proper person and present in Court Acknowledges him-
 self indebted to the Right Hon. the Lord Prop^r in the Sum of Five pounds Sterling to be made &
 Charged on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs
 and Successors Conditionally that if he doth not appear at any time during this Court sitting to
 give evidence on his said Lord Ships behalf against the said Mary Spearman where with he
 Acknowledges himself Content

Ordered by this Court that the same M^{rs} Margaret Shipping give Security for her appear-
 ance during this Court sitting to prosecute on his said Lord Ships behalf the said Mary Spearman

Thereupon Charles Hyson of Kent County Gent. and present in Court in his proper person
 and Acknowledges himself indebted to the Right Hon. the Lord Prop^r in the Sum of Five pounds -
 Sterling to be made and Charged on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of
 his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the same Margaret Shipping shall
 not any time during this Court sitting appear and prosecute on his said Lord Ships behalf against the
 said ~~Mary Spearman~~ Mary Spearman for her committing the felony aforesaid where with the said
 Charles Hyson Acknowledges himself Content

John Wright jun. aforesaid is sworn on his said Lord Ships behalf against the said Mary

 returns a bill of Indictment as follows

 the Jurisdiction of this Court with force and Arms one white Callico Gown of the value of five
 hundred pounds of Tobacco of the goods and Chattels of a certain Margaret Shipping then
 and there being found there and there feloniously did steal take and bear away contrary
 to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government
 and against the form of the act of assembly in such case lately made and provided
