 the Stande Indicted and by Thomas Smith there foreman all so Say — Therefore it

is considered by the Justice here to wit at Kent County at the Court House in the Town
 of Chester in Said County on the third tuesday in March being the nineteenth day of said
 Month Anno Domini Thousand Seven hundred and thirty three That the afd^d Mary
 Spearman stande half an hour in the pillory and receive on her bare back fifteen
 lashes well laid on ^{as a punishment for committing the felony afd^d} and also pay the four fote of the afd^d
 goods being valued at fifty pounds of Tobacco. the four fote of which amounts to the
 Sum of two hundred pounds of Tobacco to be paid to the Same Margeret Huggoy
 and also pay the Sum of Seven hundred and eighty two pounds of Tobacco Cost arising
 on the premises afd^d to the officers of this Court

It is also considered by the Court here at this day to wit the day and year
 last mentioned that the Sheriff of Kent County take the afd^d Mary Spearman into
 his Custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment afd^d Spoused and afterwards
 to bring her into Court againe of which precept to wit John Grosheam Gent Sugg
 Sheriff of Kent County makes Return on the day and year last Said that he hath
 executed the punishment in the Judgment afd^d Spoused and also hath here
