

Warrant was given to the Sheriff of Kent County that he immediately cause to come here twelve or by whom it who neither of To Recognize it because as well as of which said precept the said Sheriff to wit John Gresham Gent was here at this day to wit the nineteenth day of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty four makes Return that he hath here ready twelve or by whom it precept to wit Command and now here afterwards to wit the day and year last mentioned came againe the said the Lord Prop^r by his attorney and the said Mary Jones in her proper person and the Jurors of that Jury being Impannelled and called likewise came to wit Thomas Smith Richard Gresham Morgan Hurst John Carwit Bulman Medford Alexander Byles William Woodland John Rogers Henry Spencer John Cooper Thomas West and Arthur Miller who being duly sworn and sworn to say the truth in the premises the said Mary Jones in her proper person appears and the same Jurors upon their Oath do say Mary Jones is not guilty as the Stande Jurors and by Thomas Smith those Jurors all say: Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at their Chamber at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Wednesday in March being the nineteenth day of said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty three that the said Mary Jones as to the Indulment of the goods thereof without day and it is also considered by the Justices and that the said Mary Jones pay the sum of one thousand one hundred and ten pounds of Tobacco to be accruing on the premises and to the officers of this Court

And now here at this day the same day and last mentioned came the said Lord Prop^r by his atty and prays that the said Mary Jones may give Security for the goods and the officers of this Court and that John Gresham Gent Sheriff of Kent County keep the said Mary in safe Custody until the goods shall be satisfied
